#### EMERGE are hiring!

Applications are now being considered for the post of EMERGE Research Fellow.

Applicants should be ST4 or ST5 trainees in Emergency Medicine. This newly created one year post will allow the successful applicant 4 hours dedicated research time per week which will take the place of clinical work.

During this time, the applicant will;

1. have the opportunity to Co-PI a portfolio research study with supervision from the experienced EMERGE team and an EMERGE consultant
2. be expected to become the South East Scotland lead for the RCEM TERN (Trainee Emergency Research Network; <https://www.rcemlearning.co.uk/foamed/about-tern>) project, and
3. become the local PI for one of the new TERN projects

The hours can be worked flexibly over fortnightly periods around other clinical, training and personal commitments. This post has been approved by the EM TPD, EM CD, Dean and Associate Postgraduate Dean for South East Scotland and will aim to start in December 2018. This post will not affect a trainee's CCT date and will not count as an out of programme secondment.
